Outstanding Teens Sought

The Miss Wisconsin Organization, a preliminary to Miss America, announced this week that the fifth annual Miss Wisconsin Outstanding Teen Program is scheduled to take place on Wednesday June 17, 2009 at the Alberta Kimball Auditorium in Oshkosh. Deadline for entries is April 24, 2009.

Contestants must be female, between the ages of 13 – 17, not a graduating senior and a resident of Wisconsin. Contestants will be judged in Talent, Private Interview, Lifestyle & Fitness, Scholastic Achievement and Evening Wear/On Stage Question. Optional competitions include Most Photogenic and Best Smile.

The current Miss Wisconsin Outstanding Teen is 16-year-old Jennifer Dombrowski. Ms. Dombrowski's talent is Irish Step Dancing and her platform is promoting Literacy through Youth Mentoring. She was second among the national Teen contestants in raising funds for the Children's Miracle Network – an optional activity. She was invited to the Miss America Pageant this past January in Las Vegas to share her fund-raising ideas.

The winner of Miss Wisconsin Outstanding Teen will have the opportunity to compete for the national title of Miss America's Outstanding Teen in Orlando, Florida in August of 2009. Miss America's Outstanding Teen is a scholarship-based program. Through the efforts of thousands of volunteers across the country, the organization offers accomplished teens the opportunity to win college scholarship funds. Community service is required on the local level and a national platform is required on the state and national levels. An entry fee is required for the state competition.
